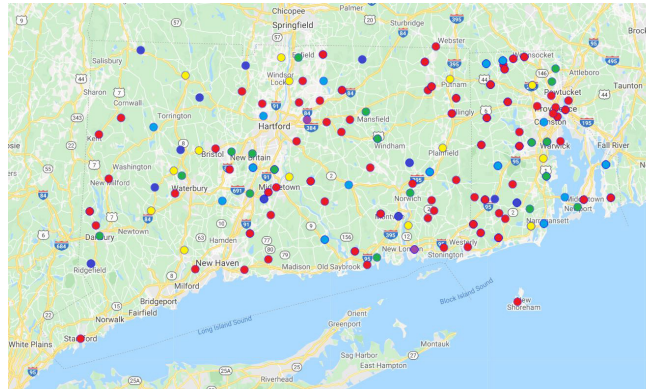

ASRWVA has full-time staff providing on-site expertise to all water systems less than 10,000 population. Source Water Protection Program assists communities in developing and implementing drinking water protection activities.

The Association provides training classes for water/wastewater system personnel and administrators on state and federal regulations, operation and maintenance, safety, administration, and finance. Certification classes are provided throughout the year and is enhanced by Workforce Development influence.

Together, we can help communicate and implement new and improved technology/infrastructure, through training and conference events. Our programs partners include EPA and USDA Rural Development.
