Circuit Rider Job Description

The purpose of the Circuit Rider Program is to protect the nation's multi-billion-dollar investment in rural and small municipal water systems by providing on-site technical assistance that assures cost- effective operations and adequate income for both operations and debt service within each State. This position provides technical, managerial, and financial assistance to water utility personnel regarding daily operations of a drinking water distribution system and/or water treatment facility. Circuit Riders provide rural and small municipal water systems on-site technical training/assistance to ensure cost effective operations and sustainable utility management within Atlantic States (CT&RI) and the other geographical jurisdictions.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Applicants shall possess knowledge of public water system operations and maintenance.
- Applicants should possess, at a minimum, education equivalent to graduation from high school and multi-year experience (preferably a minimum of 5 years) in operating and/or managing a public water system
